NEWS FROM WITHIN





I joked with SD that it's time we begin working towards the next grade but SD, a dedicated student who does not do music as subject worked tirelessly and did two Trinity in-person exams in 2023! Well done SD! All of your hard work will certainly pay off!

Together with SD, they formed the only two senior learners who had dared to sing a full concert program at the Stellenbosch Eisteddfod in 2023. The concert program consists of 12-15 minutes of contrasting repertoire sung in succession, without a break. It is a mammoth task for any young singer. JJ went on to thrill the ABRSM adjudicator with his expressive and committed performance. JJ received 89% in his grade 7 ABRSM exam.





Each year, students have the opportunity to participate in the eisteddfods. As of 2024, I'd like to encourage the singers to participate in different eisteddfods. Although the eisteddfod does create a comfortable competition environment, we usually use the opportunity as a practice round for something upcoming such as an exam. Participation in the eisteddfod is entirely up to the young singer, however, it does provide the young singer with the opportunity to receive external feedback from someone other than their teacher, and provides them with the opportunity to interact with and listen to other young singers their age.

EXTERNAL EXAMS

External exams offer a wonderful sense of encouragement to the young singers. They are reminded that they are working towards a specific goal. For those singers who wish to pursue tertiary studies abroad, these exams also offer them the opportunity to earn college credits, a system we don't really use in South Africa. Often, these exams are incredibly stressful and require the young singers to perform before an audience of one person has their head down as they are making notes and grading the performance. Many schools offer their students honours and colours awards as incentive for excelling at their external exams.



Please note the following with regards to the 2024 external exams:

- Unless you request a live or in person exam, we will do the online exams instead.
- Should you request to do an external exam, you must have at least one weekly hour of lesson.
- Accompaniment fees for the external exam are applicable but discounted should you choose Nathan Lewis as accompanist.
- All repertoire for the exam must preferably be memorized.
- The preferred exam boards are: Trinity College London & ABRSM
